## Clinical activity

I have been a full-time faculty member at the department of periodontology, Yonsei University Dental Hospital, Seoul, South Korea since 2004.

I am specialized in periodontal and implant surgeries.

Therefore, my patients are typically referred from local clinics due to the difficulty of surgery. Most of the implant cases are combined with advanced surgeries such as extensive GBR and sinus augmentation procedures.

On average, 30 implant surgeries including GBR and sinus augmentations are performed in a month.

As a periodontist, I am also specialized in periodontal plastic surgery and treatment of periimplantitis.

I have been teaching my undergraduate and postgraduate students at Yonsei University College of Dentistry, Seoul, South Korea since 2004.

The main topics of my lecture are in the field of periodontal and implant therapies.

I am also actively participating in many international symposia as an international speaker.
